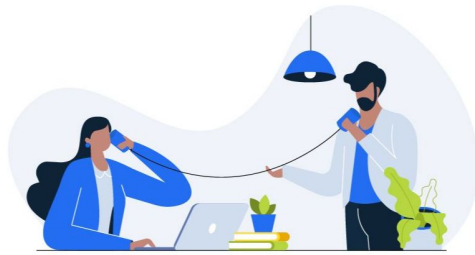
The ESES Marketplace also tracks recovery funding and other resources for small businesses like the Storefront Repair Fund highlighted below:
